

Part 1:

Part 2:

Sacrifice: In Pacific Rim Marshal Pentecost gives his life to save the earth from monsters called Kaiju and their masters called Precursors. He was dying of radiation sickness and sacrificed his life rather than the life of a healthy individual.

Faith/belief: Raleigh and Mako, the main characters, trust each other enough to drift (link minds) to pilot a Jaeger (a giant humanoid machine). Drifting allows them to see each other's memories both good and bad.

Task:

The film is about a race of monsters, called Kaiju, who break through an interdimensional portal, known as The Breach, at the bottom of the Pacific Ocean. They have been sent to earth to reform it and make it habitable for their masters, the Precursors. This means all life on earth die. The main character, Raleigh Beckett, is a young Jaeger pilot. Jaegers are giant humanoid machines, with weapons, which have been created to destroy the Kaiju. Raleigh's brother, his co-pilot, is killed during an attack from a category 3 Kaiju, called Knifehead. Raleigh is traumatised by his brother's death and loses faith in himself as a pilot so he quits the defence program. He is convinced to join again by Marshal Pentecost, the head of the program and a man he believes in, and learns to drift (pilot a Jaeger) with Mako, Marshal Pentecost's adopted daughter. Scientists discover a way to close The Breach and Raleigh, Mako and Marshal Pentecost, with the last two Jaegers, plan an attack. Marshal Pentecost and his co-pilot Chuck Hansen sacrifice themselves to save the lives of Raleigh and Mako allowing them to close The Breach.

Part 3 – An Essay

1. Films are a good way to teach people about religion as they can show the viewer clearly the difference between good and evil . In film, good nearly always wins over evil so the viewer sees that there is no benefit in being bad. This teaches us to have faith. For example, in the Lion King, the King's brother Scar murders his brother and tries to kill his cub, Simba, so that he can rule the Pride. The Pride suffers under Scar's rule and Simba returns, once he grows up, to defeat Scar and bring happiness to the Pride once again.
2. Films are not a good way to teach people about religion as the viewer might think that being bad is more fun than being good. Often the bad person in films is rich and powerful and the good is poor. They might feel that there is no benefit to being good. An example is Dora and the Lost City of Gold. Alejandro pretends to be good and help Dora, but actually is using her to find the treasure and steal the gold from Parapata. He does not want to be good because being rich is all he cares about.
