Labour Market Information (LMI) is the name for facts and figures about jobs and employment. The information is used to give an overall picture of the past, present and future of work.

The **labour market** is the term used to describe the amount of people working and looking for work, and the amount of jobs.

LMI can help you understand:



what a job involves on a day-to-day basis

LMI can help you understand:



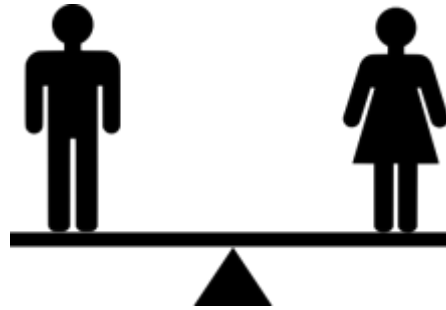
**which jobs are growing or declining – for example,

might need to do a job**

LMI can help you understand:



how much you might earn, the hours you might work, and working patterns or gender balance for a job

LMI can help you understand:



**how your interests and skills are
relevant to particular jobs**

LMI can help you understand:



what jobs there are in your region on an area you want to move to
