GCSE Results Day 2023 – Thursday 24th August

Dear Parent / Carer,

As we near the end of an incredibly successful year and exam season, I wanted to write to you to outline how students in Year 11 will receive their results, and the process for any post-results services such as reviews of marking.

GCSE Results Day is Thursday 24th August, and St George will be open for students to collect their results **between 9am-10.30am on this day**. If they are available, we highly encourage students to come into school to receive their results – it is a really wonderful opportunity to celebrate opening their GCSE results with their peers and teachers. If they are not available, and have asked someone to collect their results on their behalf, we will need written permission in order to release them; please contact me regarding this. If they are not collected by 11am on Thursday 24th August, they will be posted to them that day, so should receive them by the end of the following day.

I and other staff will be available on that morning to discuss results with students and advise them of any next steps in terms of college requirements or potential reviews of marking.

I have also attached the procedures for enquiries about results, post-results services, the costs of these, and a candidate consent form. In the unlikely event that these services are needed, please read this information about what next steps need to be taken.

I hope that you and your Year 11 students have a wonderful, well-earned and restful Summer break, and thank you for all of your support over the last year.
