Expectations outside of classroom	Develop skills whilst participating in after and out of school dance clubs. Be a rol model for younger pupils in the school; regularly increase knowledge of dance phrases and professional work practise exam papers and complete all homework.
Course description	This course will enable pupils to develop their skills, knowledge and understanding of dance as choreographer, performer and critic through:
	 Applying and adapting a wide range of skills and techniques effectively in performing an choreographing dance, including the ability to improve. Creating dances for a range of purposes and in response to a stimuli. Ability to replicate performance demonstrating Actions, Dynamics and Space. Developing the ability to analyse, evaluate and appreciate dance.

	 Set phrases through a solo performance (approximately one minute in duration) 15marks Duet/Trio performance (Three and a half minutes in duration) 25 marks
	Choreography (30%):
	• Solo or group choreography – solo (two to two and a half minutes) or a group dance for two to five dancers (three to three and a half minutes) 40 marks
	Component 2: Appreciation of Dance (40%)
	 Knowledge and understanding of choreographic processes and performing skills Critical appreciation of own work Critical appreciation of professional works 80 marks
