PUBLIC TRANSPORT LINKS TO THE COLLEGE

The information reported below refers to the Bluestar Bus Service and the South Western Railway, covering other routes to and from St George Catholic College.

BUS SERVICES

The [Bluestar 18](#) from Millbrook to the City Centre, then change to the Bluestar 2 to Bassett Green Road stop (2 minutes walk from the college).

The [Bluestar 8](#) and [Bluestar 9](#) from Fawley and Langley to the City Centre, then change to the Bluestar 2 to Bassett Green Road stop (2 minutes walk from the college).

The [Bluestar 424](#) from Hedge End and West End to Mansbridge Road (Monks Way stop - 15 minutes walk from the college).

From Fair Oak and Eastleigh the Bluestar 2 has a return service stopping at the Bassett Green Road stop on Stoneham Lane (2 minutes walk from the college).

TRAINS

Students from Whiteley and Fareham area travel to Southampton Central station, then change trains to Swaythling station (5 minutes walk from the college).

Students in Chandlers Ford can travel direct to and from Swaythling station daily. Please check the [rail networks website](#) for timetables.

A direct service is also available from Winchester to Swaythling. Please refer to rail company timetables.



COLLEGE BUS POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

“An education in the fullness of humanity should be the defining feature of Catholic schools.” Pope Francis

1.1 St George Catholic College is in the Trusteeship of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Portsmouth and maintained by Southampton City Council Local Authority. Our school leaders and governors are entrusted by the Bishop with the ministry of school leadership and will always act in recognition of the love of Christ for all members of our college community and one another.

1.2 We share a vocation for the common good in our world, and we are committed to working together as a family. All of our policies and procedures are formed to enable all members of our St George family to be safe and cherished, feel happy and fulfilled and be treated fairly in a positive environment founded on mutual respect and shared values. This policy is part of the foundation that enables everyone to aspire to be all that God has created us to be.

2. AIM

2.1 To create a safe environment for pupils to get to and from college. Parents/carers are encouraged to read this policy with their children. It is available on the website under the transport section.

3. GENERAL INFORMATION

3.1 Saint George Catholic College contracts four services with ‘GoSouthCoast/Bluestar’ & ‘Mayflower’. The buses arrive at college at approximately 8:20am every morning except for Year 7 induction day and college Inset days. Buses will depart at approximately 3:15pm each school day from the top of Leaside Way. The college also runs one minibus service which collects pupils from the Nursling and the Chandlers Ford area.

4. SERVICE DETAILS

4.1 The college bus service is offered to those who live more than 3 miles from the college. Priority is given according to age then distance, with youngest pupils first and then pupils living furthest away from the college. The same priorities are applied to the waiting list for all services. This will enable your son/daughter to have a trouble-free journey to and from college. The advantages of this transport are:

- a. Cost-effective and convenient transport in all weathers
- b. Safety and convenience of one bus direct to the college gates with no changes
- c. Pupils will not receive a late mark should the bus be delayed due to weather/traffic
- d. A dedicated email transport@stgcc.co.uk for help and complaints.

5. PAYMENT PROCEDURE

5.1 Pay online at www.scopay.com/stgeorge-soton using the personal link code supplied by the college.

5.2 The payment schedule letter is attached in Appendix A. Payments via SCOPAY only.

6. PUBLISHED ROUTES

For the latest timetables and routes, please see the Transport Information Booklet (above).

6.1 Buses will pick pupils up and drop off at the pre-published bus stops. Buses will not wait for students that are late.

7. BEHAVIOUR TO AND FROM COLLEGE FOR STUDENTS

7.1 Students are expected to arrive and leave school in full school uniform. If the weather is poor then pupils can wear coats and jackets over the top of their school uniform. Hoodies and sweatshirts are not permitted.

7.2 Pupils must always act in a respectful manner to all people they may encounter on the journey to and from college.

7.3 If travelling on a bus service, pupils must:

- a. Sit on an individual seat
- b. Pupils must not stand up (if a seat is available)
- c. Pupils must remain seated and not turn around.
- d. Pupils must not do anything that might distract the bus driver or put other pupils in danger. This includes turning around, shouting, swearing, fighting, throwing items, spraying drinks and aerosol cans, taking pictures or filming on mobile phones.

7.4 Concerns of bullying or inappropriate behaviour witnessed by students on the bus or complaints from parents/carers should be emailed to transport@stgcc.co.uk for the attention of the transport co-ordinator. Alternatively, students can raise their concerns to their Progress Leader or a member of staff who is always on bus duty at the beginning and end of the day.

8. RULE VIOLATIONS PROCEDURE

8.1

- a. Reports of rule violations will be investigated by either the Transport Manager or the Progress Leader for that pupil's year group. The college reserves the right to withdraw bus passes from pupils who behave poorly on the school bus service. Persistent poor behaviour will result in a letter being sent home with details of the sanction. This can range from a permanent ban from all school services to a temporary ban lasting a number of weeks.
- b. Those using the Bluestar pass app and found to be sharing it with another student may have their pass deactivated without notice by the Bluestar app monitoring team.
- c. Any unpaid fares will be passed to Southampton City Council's Debt department for collection.
- d. It is your responsibility to provide a working email address for a QR code to be sent to activate your child's bus pass.

9. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

9.1 On rare occasions, the college reserves the right to take back a pupil's seat once it has been offered. The oldest pupils, i.e. those in Year 11 and Year 10, will be approached first. An example of this would be the late arrival of a student who is:

- a. Looked after (in foster care)
- b. Has SEN or a disability
- c. Any other reason at the discretion of the Headteacher / Governors.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

You need to book or re-book now if you require a seat for September 2026 by following this link and completing the online booking form: [Dedicated School Transport 2026-2027 Booking Application \(whole school\) - Fill in form.](#)

Please contact the college if you do not receive a booking confirmation within 7 days of submission (except during school holidays).

The application closing date is Friday 19 June 2026.

Services are only offered to those who live more than 3 miles from the college or where there is not a direct route available on public services. The advantages are:

- Safety and convenience of one bus direct to the college gates with no changes;
- Students will not receive a late mark if the bus is delayed due to weather or traffic;
- An electronic bus pass/app (Bluestar passes only - these can be used on all public routes term time, half-terms and weekends). Hard copies are available on request;
- Track your bus and view its arrival time via the Bluestar / ShuttleID Mayflower app.

From September 2026, a deposit of £175 is required no later than 7 August 2026 to secure a seat - followed by payments in advance.

SCOPAY registration information will be given to your child on their Year 6 Induction Day on Wednesday 1 July 2026.

Please note: assisted places are available for those eligible. This is subject to meeting the means-tested criteria (child entitled to free school meals or parents are in receipt of maximum Working Tax Credit or Universal Credit, with an earned income of no more than £7,400).

If you think you qualify for funded transport, you will need to apply online by following this link:

Re-applying for funding: you MUST apply every year. However, there is no need to submit a copy of your child's baptism certificate or acceptance letter as evidence again; they will have this on file. You will need to mention this in the relevant section.

First time applicants: a copy of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate or an acceptance letter from the Head Teacher must be included to support your application. (If you require a letter from the Head Teacher, please contact me).

Failure to keep payments up to date or poor behaviour will result in your child losing their seat.

Priority will initially be given on distance and to Year 7 and Year 8 students; the remainder will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. As there is only one school bus each way per day, it is imperative that your child arrives at their stop 5 minutes before the bus is due, as the driver must keep to a timetable and cannot be delayed.

Timetables are available for viewing/downloading on the college website: www.stgcc.co.uk with further information on other public transport services available across the Hampshire area.

May I remind you that college transport does NOT OPERATE on the first day for Year 7 students. Therefore, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to arrange this.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR ELECTRONIC / QR BUS PASS

- You will receive a "Gift Code/QR Code" via email from your operator by no later than Friday 10th July 2026;
- If booked on the 301, your child will need to download the Bluestar app on their phone (NOT yours);
- Bus passes will not become active until the morning of Friday 4th September 2026;
- Hard Copy bus passes are available should your child not have a smart phone. To place an order, send a passport style photo of your child, plus an image of their QR code from shuttleID to: transport@stgcc.co.uk by no later than 17th July 2026.

On rare occasions, the college reserves the right to take back a pupil's seat once it has been offered. Our oldest pupils in Years 11 and 10 will be approached first. An example would be the late admission of a student who is:

- Looked after (in foster care);
- Has SEN or a disability - physical, emotional or cognitive;
- Any other reason at the discretion of the Head Teacher/Governors.

PREFER A PUBLIC SERVICE ROUTE, BUT NOT SURE WHICH ONE

If you are unsure which public service is the best option for your child, just enter the college postcode "SO16 3DQ" into Google Maps, click "directions" and enter your home address. Adjust the "arrive by" time to 8.20am. The results will look similar to the image below with all available route options listed.

Bluestar/Unilink offer a "Child Southampton Zone" ticket at the very reasonable rate of just £13 per week.

TRAVEL CODE OF CONDUCT TERMS & CONDITIONS

- As there is a waiting list for all services, failure to keep payments up to date will result in your child losing his/her seat. We do not expect payments to fall behind at any time;
- Late applications for assisted/funded transport will incur the daily rate payable to the college;
- No refunds are given for absence due to a family holiday, sickness or injuries (except in extreme circumstances). Refunds are only given if you are willing to let the seat be sold permanently to the next student on the waiting list;

- On occasions, cover drivers will be used when usual drivers are either on sick leave or holiday. So it is your child's responsibility to wave at the approaching bus driver for him/her to stop as the driver may not be familiar with which students use which stop;
- If you decide at a later date that you no longer need transport, we will require a "10-school-day notice period", so it is imperative you inform the college as soon as possible. Failure to inform the college will result in fees being incurred;
- Any inappropriate behaviour reported will be dealt with by our Senior Management Team and Head Teacher. Fees will still apply if any student is set a temporary ban from the service;
- Any student who screenshots or shares their bus pass will have their passes automatically deactivated without notice by the Bluestar/ShuttleID app monitoring team for 24 hours;
- Should your child receive a detention, take up an after-school activity or stay behind for additional studies, the college is not responsible to fund or find alternative transport. Any unpaid fares will be passed to Southampton City Council's Debt department for collection. It is your responsibility to provide a working email address (parent or child's) for the QR / Gift Code to be sent to;
- **Important:** the college has the right to withdraw any service from the timetable giving one full term's notice without prejudice.

By applying to travel on the college bus, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions as set out in this letter and the attached Transport Policy.

You need to reconfirm or reserve your seat NOW for September 2026 by completing the [online form](#) by no later than Friday 19th June 2026. If you do not receive a confirmation of your booking within 7 days of submitting your form (except during holidays) please contact the college.

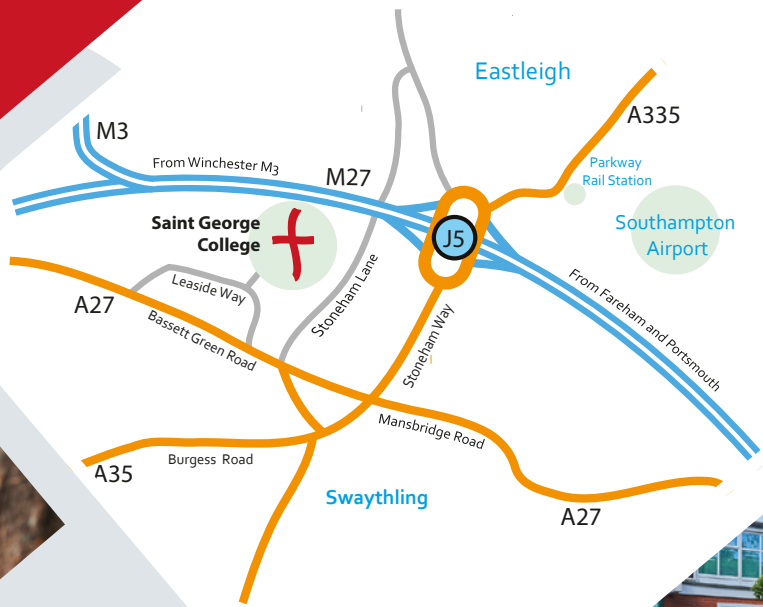
